Quantifying Abuse is a humanitarian initiative to **introduce data metrics into the court system to mitigate, and eventually eliminate, the risks of domestic violence.**

Quantifying Abuse introduces a **comprehensive data structure by which to measure emotional abuse**; connecting the stories of all abuse victims so it is measurable, traceable, and can be managed.

Quantifying Abuse will **identify individuals within our society whom have neurological issues which allow them to hurt others without empathy.**

Quantifying abuse will work to identify abusers so that early intervention is possible.

5 Steps to Save the World

the scope of this project is not small; and there is challenges forecasted **especially in light of the controversial nature of this project.**

We will be proceeding knowing that there will likely be pushback. Many profit off of the system as it stands.

Thankfully this plan will work both from the bottom up and the top down. **Once the data set has started, it will be difficult to stop;** once metrics are introduced they will be able to be utilized within all cases going forward.

To facilitate this the plan is to work via domestic abuse agencies, governments, legal organizations, and the general public to ensure that it is successful.

When the judgements are made, a range will start to naturally appear within the data which can be easily utilized for basically every case in which consistent metrics also apply.

Standardization & Decommision of Judicial Processes

Once the same metrics are reviewed multiple times, Judges will start to get frustrated with the monotony of the rulings because they have become so consistent that they take no cognition to make. They will be practically a figurehead in the role which is when old policies can be decommissioned.

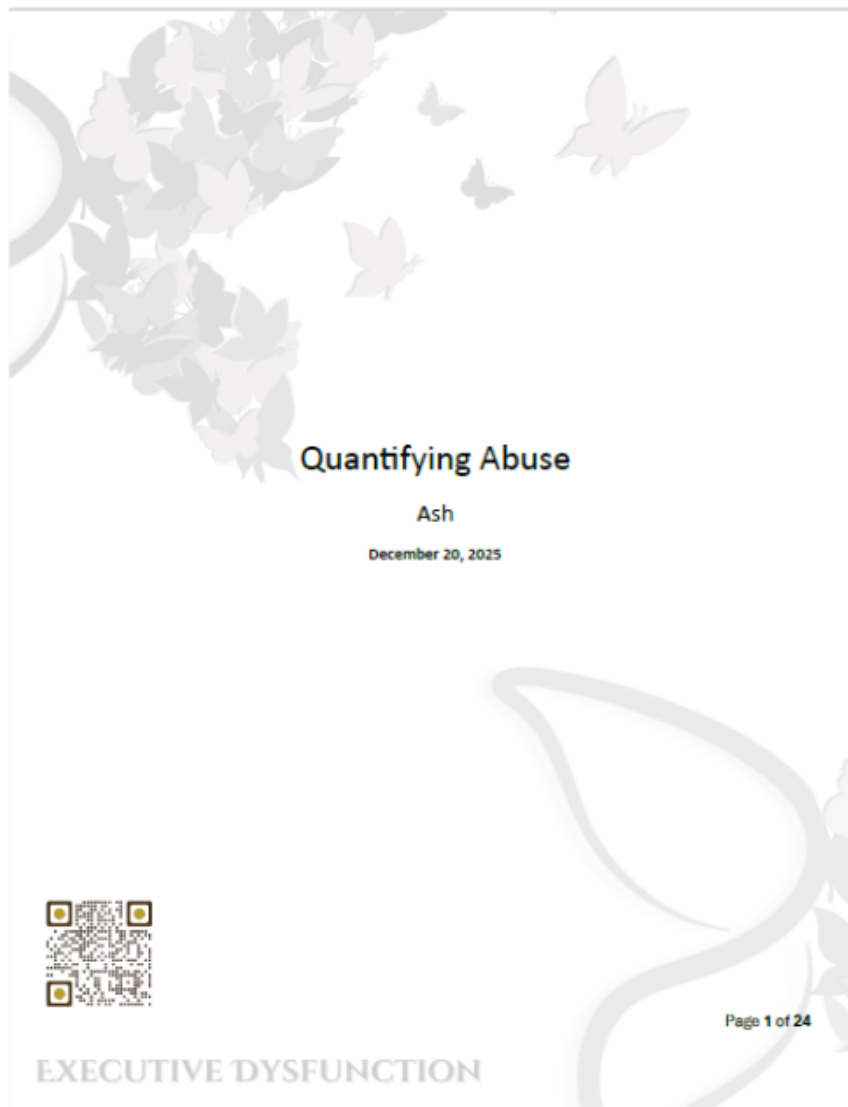

Quantifying Abuse Report

Quantifying Abuse is a 24 page report that is uniquely structured. Written by a data analyst, Quantifying Abuse is structured to facilitate universal understanding of the concepts.

The report is split into 2 parts.

- Structure of Emotional Abuse
- Final Metrics of my Case

The report is written and designed to facilitate the development of an AI product wherein these metrics can be produced without the need of human interaction.

This will ensure that abusers are identified in high conflict situations and can be helped before further abuse occurs (financial, legal, appeals, parental alienation, etc).

Quantifying Abuse Structure

Emotional Abuse



The most valuable thing within this report is the structure by which we are going to measure the abuse.

For this system to be applied in an effective manner, consistent metrics are required; consistent metrics means will facilitate comparison between cases and tracking via a centralized data bank. Consistent data will provide analytics that can ultimately result in behavioral change.

The abuse "types" are three actions taken from a abuser towards a victim as a form of emotional abuse. These types (Blaming, Demeaning, and Threatening) are actions taken towards the victim.

The Vehicles are the delivery system for the types of abuse; they are how the abuser utilizes the incidences in the trifecta against the victim.

As detailed in the report, the trifecta is comprehensive and can be implemented. The vehicles are for discussion/development.



Social Media & Presence

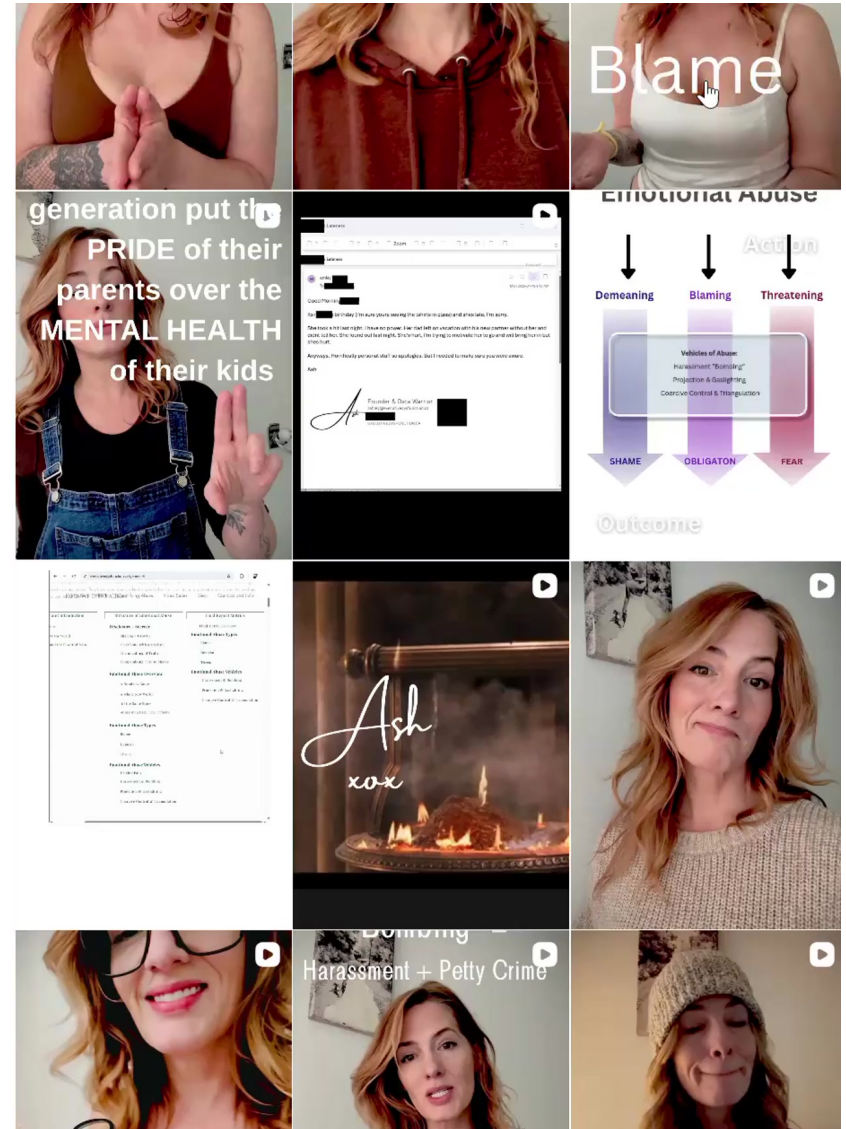
Following the release of the Quantifying Abuse Report on December 20th 2025, the video series was developed to socialize the concepts discussed in the report.

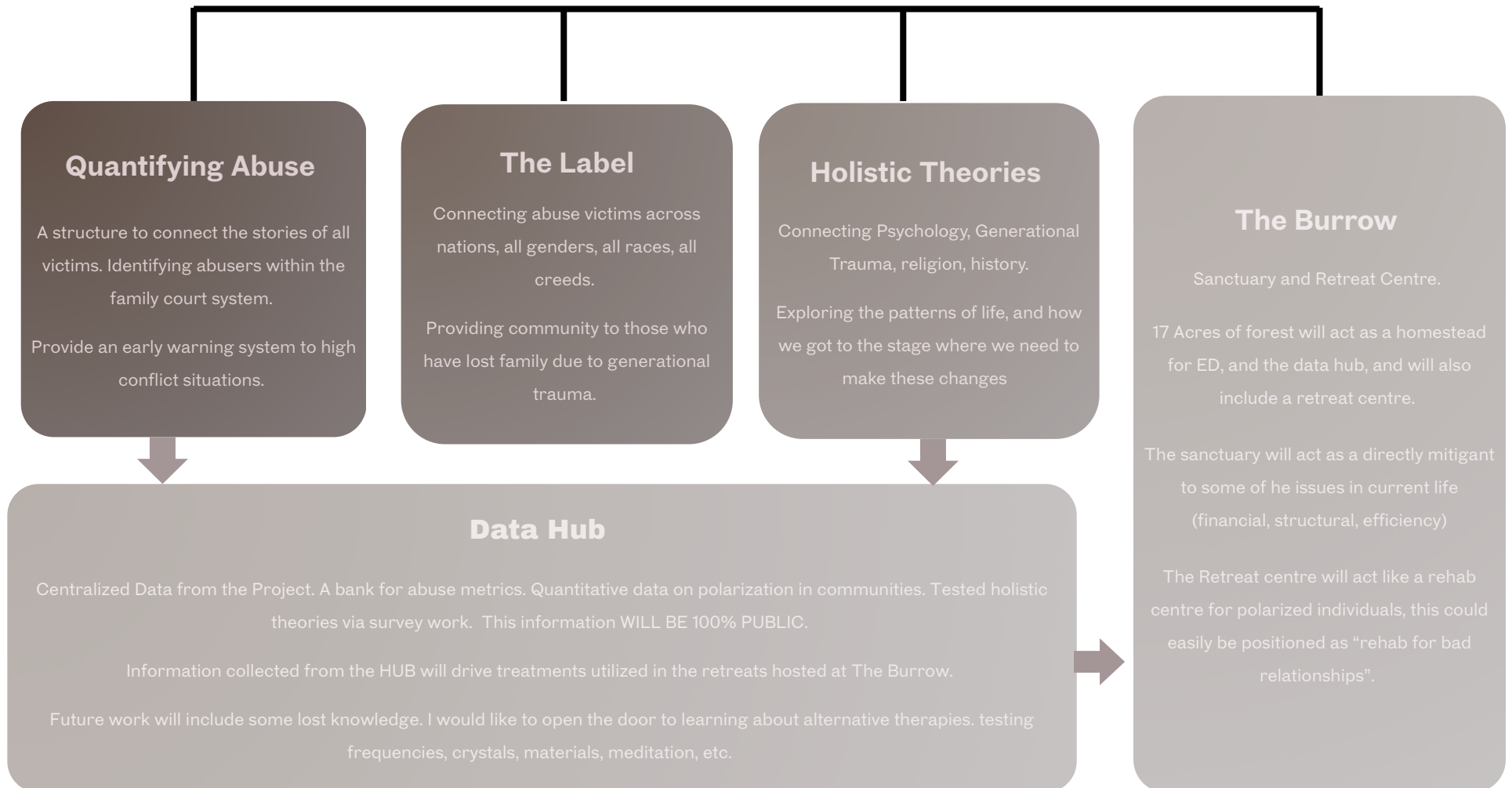

2A. Metrics into the Court System

Pre requisites

- Guidance Materials - Training & Metric Calculations
- Regional Ambassadors

To facilitate this messaging going in at a deep level, I would like to hire “ambassadors” which will act as such and do the groundwork with the impacted organizations. This will be a relationship management position and will only be needed for a short period to socialize the concept.

This is fundamental for buy in. Humans meeting humans.

6 contractors x 25,000

3A. Institutional Support

Facilitate the launch of Quantifying Abuse via engagement with regional representation in impacted organizations.

Pre requisite: Regional Ambassadors (Contract roles)

- Build and maintain a group of local stakeholders within the domestic abuse industry; to include, but not limited to: domestic abuse organizations, courts, legal representation,
- Provide training and guidance on the system
- Work through stakeholders to identify appropriate victims for metric calculation

3B. DA Victim Stakeholders

Work with domestic abuse victims to calculate the metrics for their cases; Facilitate the recording of the metrics in the court proceedings.

Pre requisite: Domestic Abuse Victims

- Develop and maintain relationships with domestic abuse victims.
- Work with domestic abuse victims to ensure the data for their case is appropriately tracked and recorded.
- Calculate consistent metrics & record these in the data hub

Cost Projections

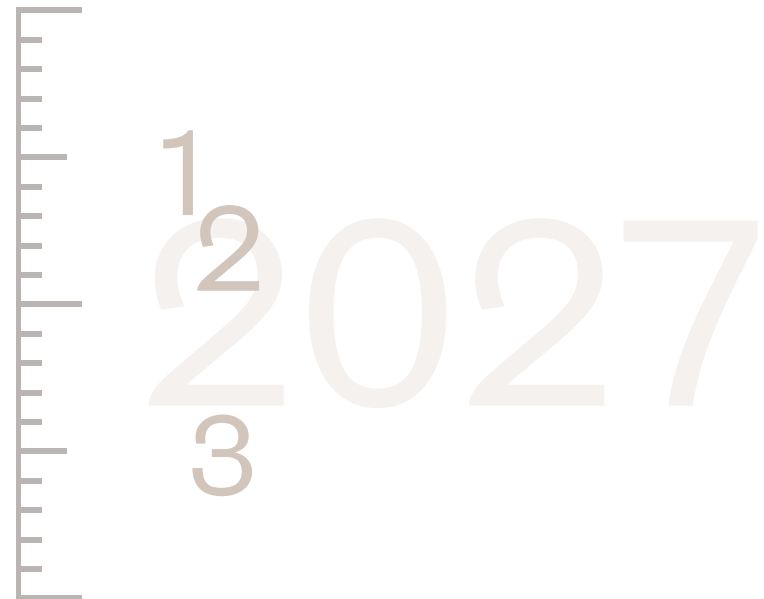
Due to the limited knowledge of the organization in terms of App development, this component of the project is best served with technological expertise around the table.
